





## **Cervical Cancer Screening**

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### **Measure Specifications**

Women 21-64 years of age who were screened for cervical cancer using either of the following:

- Ask patients at every annual exam when their last health screening was and document DATE and RESULT in the EMR even if your office didn't order or conduct the screening.
- This information <u>can</u> be captured during telehealth visits as well.
- A note such as "Last Pap June 2022, result normal, HPV negative" is compliant for this measure.

#### **Cervical Cytology**

21-64 years of age who had a cervical cytology performed within the past 3 years. (Pap Test)

# Cervical High-Risk human papillomavirus (hrHPV) testing

30-64 years of age who had a cervical high-risk human papillomavirus testing performed within the last 5 years. (hrHPV/HPV)

#### Cervical Cytology with hrHPV cotesting

30-64 years of age who had a cervical cytology/high-risk human papillomavirus cotesting with int the last 5 years. (hrHPV/HPV & Pap Test)

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
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


The Cervical Cancer Screening Measure collects documentation for women 21-64 years of age who were screened for cervical cancer. We are looking for cervical cytology (Pap) for women 21-64 within the past 3 years. We are looking for cervical high-risk HPV testing for women 30-64 within the last 5 years. Or cervical cytology with HPV co-testing for women 30-64 within the last 5 years.

This can be compliant with notes in your EMR. A simple note that states "Last pap June 2022, result normal, HPV negative" is all we need. This can be noted even if your office didn't order or conduct the screening and can be noted during telehealth visits as well. Ask every female patient in this age range at every visit.
