### Collaborative Care Model Grant Opportunities

Applicable to: Mercy Care Complete Care, Mercy Care ACC-RBHA, Mercy Care Long Term Care, Mercy Care DD, and Mercy Care DCS CHP

Mercy Care would like to share information from the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) about two grant opportunities for setting up Collaborative Care Model (CoCM) in primary care practices. The Collaborative Care Uptake Fund Program is administered by the Arizona Primary Care Office (PCO) within the Bureau of Women and Children's Health (BWCH) of the ADHS, Division of Public Health Prevention Services. The Collaborative Care Uptake Fund is established specifically to award grants for:

- Primary care physicians who are in a medical practice with not more than fifty (50) employees to meet the initial costs of establishing and delivering behavioral health integration services through the CoCM; and
- Establishing Collaborative Care Technical Assistance Centers for the purpose of providing technical assistance to primary care physicians on providing services through the CoCM.
