Excessive Heat Warning from 7/19 & 7/20/2024

Applicable to: Mercy Care Complete Care, Mercy Care ACC-RBHA, Mercy Care Long Term Care, Mercy Care DD, Mercy Care DCS CHP and Mercy Care Advantage

The National Weather Service (NWS) has issued an Excessive Heat Warning in effect from 10am Friday 7/19 until 8pm Saturday 7/20... for The Northwest Valley of the Phoenix Metro Area, The East Valley of the Phoenix Metro Area, Buckeye/Avondale, Deer Valley, Central Phoenix, North Phoenix/Glendale, Scottsdale/Paradise Valley, South Mountain/Ahwatukee, and Southeast Valley/Queen Creek, Central La Paz County, Kofa, Yuma, Southeast Yuma County, Gila River Valley, Central and Southern Mohave county including the Kingman area.
